The set up for the Arama is Friday, April 08, 2016 from 7:00 pm - 9:00 pm at Illiana Christian High School. There will be workshops in Leather Craft, Model Car Building, & Wood Craft, 10:00 am to 11:30 am for anyone. **Derby entrants must be registered before doing a workshop.** Derby registration will be from 10:00 am until noon on Saturday. Arama Awards will be from 12:00 to 12:30 PM. Races will begin at 12:30PM. Every car entered in the races must have a boy to race it. Every club is allowed 2 boys for race and 2 for show from each grade and 2 for race in the open class. Counselors are needed to work on Saturday. Each club who enters cars in the Derby is asked to provide at least 3 counselors or junior counselors to work on Saturday and at least 3 business ads for the program booklet. A work schedule will be handed out on the Friday night before the derby. Enclosed in this packet is the following:

Model Car Derby Construction Rules

1. Each cadet shall be allowed to construct one car with the aid and advice of his father and/or counselor.
2. All cars shall be constructed from only one current official car kit, available through the council quartermaster.
3. The wheel base, ground clearance, and distance between the wheels (tread) shall not be altered.
4. The cars may not exceed 3 inches in width (from center of car in both directions cannot exceed 1 ½ inches).
5. The car shall not weigh more than eight ounces.
6. All weights must be built into the car, no glued or taped on weights will be permitted.
7. Cars with loose parts or cars with loose parts due to poor construction practices will be disqualified.
8. Wheels, axles, and body components must be those from the official kit. Use of any parts or materials other than those specified will result in disqualification.
9. Four washers are included in the kit, one washer shall be placed behind each wheel to act as a spacer to reduce wheel rub against the body.
10. Decorative accessories are to be formed from the materials listed (see materials list).
No plastic model parts are permitted. No decals may be used except for official identification numbers assigned by your counselor.
11. The following materials are not included in the official kit, but may be used in the construction of your car:
 - Glue
 - Paint or finishing material
 - Wood Filler or plastic wood, used only under these conditions:
 - It is used as a surface preparation for sanding and final finishing.
 - It is not to be used as a molded material to build up, form or mold some part of the car.

Body style is a matter of choice. Be sure you follow the rule of wheel base and the rules on materials and their uses.

THESE RULES ARE FOR BOTH RACE AND SHOW CARS.

If you have any questions, ask you counselor, he will be able to get the answer for you.

Each car in the derby must be numbered as follows: the number on the car will be preceded by the letter found at the left of the club's name. The first numeral after the letter will identify the grade group of the car's owner, so 2 indicates 2nd grade, 4 for 4th grade, etc. The third number will be a 1,2,3 or 4. 1 and 2 for race. 3 or 4 for show. For example: B72 indicates a car from the Orland Park CRC, club #2709, Belonging to a 7th grader and is the 2nd car in race for that club. For the show portion the number should read B73 or B74.
